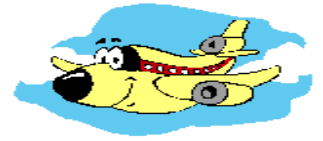

P&N POLICY REMINDERS

When a master switch is left on after a flight, the last person that flew the airplane will be charged \$25.00. Not turning off the master switch causes a \$345.00 battery to fail and not be rechargeable. **Use the check list** that is required by the FAA that can be found in all P&N flight bags. Using the list will help you remember to do your 'After Landing Check' and shut off ALL electrical switches in the airplane.

"No shows" will be charged \$25.00 for the instructor's time. Call the Marion Airport Office at 319-377-0457 at least 1/2 hour **BEFORE** your scheduled lesson if you need to cancel.

Flight lessons are to be scheduled and/or cancelled by calling the Marion Airport Office at 319-377-0457.
